We're not looking for audited financial statements, lists of board members and staff, or tons of supporting documents. Rather, this application is designed to help you tell us about your great idea – and your concrete, thoughtful plan for turning it into reality. You can submit this application one of two ways:

- 1) Print the application, fill it out and mail it back to us
- 2) Fill in this writable PDF, save it to your computer system, e-mail it back to us as an attachment or print a copy to mail it to us

If you're sending us additional information that can't be sent electronically, please send the application and all supporting materials to us by US mail. There is no deadline for applying for a grant from the *I Could Do Great Things Foundation*. We will review and respond to your application as soon as possible after we receive it.
